LOOKING AFTER LEATHER

Leather is designed to last a long time with proper care, so here's how you can help your Buckaroo leather last:

- Remove tools from the product and ensure all dust and debris is removed
- Use a dry rag to wipe down the entire product, for toolbelts, concentrate on the leather components only
- Wipe down the product with a damp cloth, remove any mud concrete, etc., from leather surfaces as soon as possible to avoid damaging the leather
- Hang the item up to dry before continuing, it should have at least six hours to air dry in a well-ventilated area
- Apply a leather protector and wait the recommended 24 48-hours for it to dry before using again
- Instruct customers to test any shampoos or balms on a hidden section of the product
- Buckaroo sells a leather balm on our retail site to help prolong the life of our leather products

Failure to correctly care for the product through neglect, misuse, the use of chemical deodorizers or cleaners, or tampering of the product will result in the product being disqualified from warranty.
