



# H-CLASS VACUUM RETURN PROCESS

All H-Class Dust Extractors must be prepared and packaged in accordance with the below guidelines. BOSCH will not accept any hazardous extractors that are not prepared in the following manner.


#### STEP 1

Do not return accessories. Such as hoses, suction pipes, bags & filters.



## STEP 2

Before returning the dust extractor, remove any disposal bags or safety filter bags.



#### STEP 3

The housing of the dust extractor must be thoroughly vacuumed and wiped clean with a damp cloth.



## STEP 4

Ensure the extractor is closed securely & the intake cap is in place as pictured.



#### STEP 5

Place vacuum into a new clean 200UM clear bag & apply duct tape to neck of bag.

Complete this step twice. (Double bag)



# STEP 6

Once double bagged and securely sealed, place the vacuum into a carton for delivery.



## STEP 7

Print out & place dangerous goods label supplied by BOSCH onto carton.



## STEP 8

Sign & complete dangerous good declaration.
